The Volleyball team had four players named to the All-Region IX team and three All-NCCAC players. The Women's basketball team had three players named to the All-Region IX team and two All-NCCAC players. The Men's basketball team had one player named to the All-Region IX team and three All-NCCAC players. The softball team had two players named to the All-Region IX team. The baseball team had six players named to the All-Region IX team and one was named Freshman of the Year. The golf team had two golfers named to the All-Region IX team, the NJCAA Division 1 Ping All-District team as well as a trip to the National Tournament. Forty-four MCC student athletes earned All-Academic honors. Twenty-nine were named to the NJCAA All-Academic teams including; seven first team, fourteen second team, and eight third team. In addition to the NJCAA honors, these twenty-nine MCC student-athletes and fifteen others were selected to the Region IX All-Academic team.

Hayley Kobza Head Coach

Coach Hayley Kobza is in her sixth year as the coach of the Lady Indians.

Kobza was named the Nebraska Community College Athletic Conference Coach of the Year in 2018 and 2019. Her teams have gone 11-1 in the conference games over the past three seasons. She won NCCAC championships in 2019 and 2020 – the school's first since 1984.

Since taking over a team that won just two games the season before her arrival, MCC has increased its win total and decreased losses for three straight seasons before this year's shift to an abbreviated spring schedule. After improving to 8-24 in her first season, the Lady Indians have won more than they've lost since 2017. Since that time, MCC has averaged 20.7 wins each season. Her career mark stands at 91-81 with a .529 winning percentage.

For each of the past three years the Lady Indians have knocked ranked opponents. In 2019 MCC snapped a 58-match losing streak to Western Nebraska, ranked 17th nationally at the time, on Halloween Night.

The McCook Community College volleyball team finished the 2021 spring season at 15-10 and gained the third seed in the Region IX South Division [5-5].

The Lady Indians won their first two matches in the Region IX tournament over Western Wyoming and Central Wyoming before falling to Western Nebraska and Laramie County Community College to finish the year at 17-12.

Six MCC volleyball players were selected for post-season awards earlier in the spring of 2021. MCC had one player from the 2016 team continue her career at Chadron State College. Two players from the 2017 squad continued their careers in Arkansas. In 2018 and 2019, all 11 sophomores earned scholarships at four-year schools. This year, four out of the five sophomores are moving on to four-year schools along with a redshirt freshman and a true freshman.

Recently the Athletic Directors in Region IX named Kobza the Assistant Women's Region IX Director for all women's sports, and she also serves as the chairperson for volleyball in the Region IX South Division.

Hayley and husband, Clay, have two children, Tripp and Leddy.

Hannah Emerson Assistant Coach

Former McCook Community College volleyball standout Hannah Emerson is back on campus this fall as an assistant for Hayley Kobza, who recruited, signed, and helped Emerson realize her dream of playing NCAA Division I volleyball.

During her two seasons at MCC, the Lady Indians won 20 games in back-to-back years – the first 20-win seasons in recent memory – and captured the school's first Nebraska Community College Athletic Conference championship since 1980.

Emerson, a 6-2 middle from Greeley West High School in Colorado came to an MCC open tryout in late 2016, earned a scholarship, and played for the Lady Indians in the 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 seasons.

She received honorable mention on the Omaha World-Herald All-Nebraska team for players from two-year colleges, playing in 35 matches her Senior year with her blocking numbers in the top 10 in the Region IX South Division. Her 106 block assists were ninth highest in the nation among the 93 schools participating in Division I.

In 2019 she signed on to play at NCAA Division I Coastal Carolina. In her senior season there, she played in 10 matches, starting one, and played in 16 sets with seven kills and six blocks on the season. She also was named to the 2019–20 Sun Belt Conference Academic Honor Roll.

While at Conway, S.C. spending last fall playing in her senior season at Coastal Carolina, she also worked as a strength and conditioning intern with the Chanticleer football team.

Emerson graduated in August of 2021 with a bachelor's degree in exercise science.

She studied kinesiology at MCC, and will also work as a Resident Assistant in Brooks Hall.







Tyler Loop Head Coach

This is Tyler Loop's tenth year of coaching golf for McCook Community College taking over the program for the 2013–2014 season.

In the spring of 2021, the MCC golf team finished the regular season second in Region IX to Eastern Wyoming, but for the third time in four years, MCC competed in the National Junior College Athletic Association Championships. (The NJCAA cancelled the tournament in 2020.) The Indians finished 22nd and capped off the regular season ranked 21st in the NJCAA rankings.

Freshman Filip Lanc' (Czech Republic) and sophomore Deniz Sari (Koblenz, Germany) were both named to the All-Region IX team, as well as the NJCAA Division I PING All-America and All-District Teams.

Sari will continue his collegiate career with Delta State, a Division II school in Cleveland, Mississippi. KC Carlson (Delta, CO.) signed on to play at William Woods, an NAIA school in Fulton, MO. Kojie Santos (Melbourne, Australia) signed on with Wilson College, a Division III school in Chambersberg, PA.

In 2020, the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) named MCC the top academic golf team in the nation, with MCC compiling a 3.67 grade-point average. The Indians had the top academic scores from among 180 junior college golf programs across the nation. In 2021, the team posted a 3.49 team GPA, which was 12th in the nation and tops among MCC's six athletic teams.

Following the 2018 season under Loop's leadership, the Indians claimed their first regional championship since 1973.

Loop is a native of McCook and a former MCC golfer himself. He and his wife, Tyler Sue, have three children, Kapri, Keaton and Amity.

This is Nick Nothnagel's seventh year as an assistant coach for the McCook Community College golf team. Nick is also a native of McCook, an MCC golf alumni, and a local business owner. He and his wife, Hannah, have two young boys.
