INDIANS BASKETBALL 2015 - 2016 COACHING STAFF



Brandon Lenhart Head Coach

Brandon Lenhart begins his 9th season as the head coach of the McCook Community College Indians. Lenhart has had the privilege of helping produce 6 All-Region IX players, 24-NCCAC All-Conference Players, 5 All-Region IX Tournament Team Players, 4 Academic All-Americans, 12 Academic All-Region, and 17 Academic All-Conference Players since taking over the program in 2007.

The MCC Indians come into the 2015-2016 season with a lot of positive momentum from the past two seasons. MCC has combined to win 37 games the past two years, and also had two top 10 finishes in NJCAA Division I in points per game. In 2013-2014, MCC finished 21-11 and averaged 96ppg, and in 2014-2015 MCC finished 16-15 and averaged 94ppg.

MCC will look to keep their full court "40 Minutes of Fury" style of play for this season, and experience will look to fuel the system. MCC has six returners from last season, and one returner from the 13–14 season (Evan Drake). The other six returners are Hakim Davis, Peter Puondak, Will Deng, Marquis White, Alex Kaup, and Brody Sharkey, who red shirted last season. MCC also added some experience with sophomore transfer Matt McLeod (Ainsworth HS/Central CC), who averaged 10ppg last year for the Raiders.

Davis is the leading returning scorer for MCC, averaging 12ppg last year being able to drive the basketball and shooting 47% from the field. Puondak is the leading rebounder returning for the Indians, averaging 5rpg last year, as well as getting 9ppg. Deng will be able to provide some versatility and play multiple positions for MCC, and Marquis White can play both guard positions, and averaged 5ppg along with 2rpg and 2apg a season ago. Alex Kaup is a player that has improved immensely for MCC, and provides a shooting threat from the three-point line. Kaup averaged 5ppg a season ago, shooting 47% from the field and 50% from the three-point line.

MCC Coach Brandon Lenhart brought in eight newcomers who will be playing college basketball for the first time in the 2015–2016 season – Daniel Arp, Chuol Biel, Draylan Perkins, Brandon Goldsmith, Javonta Daniel, Kafani Williams, Lewis Diankulu, Isaiah Bellamy, and Trey Moore. Bellamy has been sidelined with ankle surgery and rehabilitation, and Moore will red shirt this season.

Lenhart resides in McCook with his wife, Gail, and newborn son Brandt.

Brandon Pritchett begins his 6th season as an assistant for McCook Community College.



Brandon Pritchett Assistant Coach

A native to Phoenix, Arizona, Pritchett graduated from Northern Arizona University in 2005 with a bachelor's degree in Hotel and Restaurant Management and a minor in Athletic Coaching. Brandon obtained his Master's in Sports Management from the United States Sports Academy. As part of his Master's, he helped create and launch the McCook CC Indians Athletic website. In addition to his basketball duties at MCC, Coach Pritchett serves as the Area Enrollment Counselor for Mid-Plains Community College. Brandon resides in McCook with his wife, Jasmine, and their 3-year old daughter, Amiya.



Kellen Fernetti Assistant Coach

Kellen Fernetti begins his 4th season as an assistant coach for McCook Community College. Kellen came to McCook from William Woods University in Fulton, MO, where he served as assistant men's basketball coach. Coach Fernetti also earned a Master's Degree in Athletic/Activities Administration during his time at William Woods University.

Fernetti received his bachelor's degree in recreation management from Hannibal–LaGrange College in 2006. He was a two-time All–American Midwest Conference selection at H–LG. In 2003–04, Fernetti led the NAIA in three–point field goals made. He was named the NAIA National Player of the Week during the 2004 season. Coach Fernetti played two seasons at John Wood Community College prior to attending Hannibal–LaGrange. He was an All–Conference selection his sophomore year. Fernetti holds the school record for three–pointers in a game (nine), in a season (106) and in a career (196) at John Wood.

In addition to his basketball duties at MCC, Fernetti also serves as the full time assistant housing director in Brooks Hall on the campus of McCook Community College

Jon Froelich Head Coach

The University of Kansas graduate is starting his third season as the head coach for McCook Community College. A head coach since 1982, Froelich has built a solid basketball reputation. The 1997 Texas Association of Private and Parochial Schools "Coach of the Year", Froelich has coached at the high school and college level, and has also been very active in AAU basketball, taking numerous teams to national tournaments.

In his first two seasons at MCC, the Lady Indians had several outstanding individual accomplishments, with nine players earning Academic All-Region honors last season. Four players from the 2013–2014 team moved on and are now playing at a four-year college or university level, including Cydnee Ceballos at Division 1 Seattle University. A total of thirteen players have earned Academic-All-Region and Academic NCCAC honors over the past two seasons.

Six players have earned all Nebraska Community College honors while playing for Froelich, with three players being named to the All-Region IX squads, including Chante Church and Kendra Baucom (All-Defensive Team) from the 2014-2015 team.

Church, Baucom and Lucia Archuleta were all named to the Omaha World Herald All-Nebraska team, with Church also being chosen to represent MCC in the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) Coaches All-Star Weekend in July (2015).

The Lady Indians finished in the top 20 in the nation (NJCAA) last year in both three-point baskets made and three-point percentage. Teams coached by Froelich consistently rank at the top of the class as it relates to academics. The 2014–2015 team finished the year with a team grade point average of 3.43, good for 11th in the country.




William Ortiz Assistant Coach


